


LITHUANIAN EXPORT IS DOMINATED BY MANUFACTURING SECTOR














Lithuanian industry - CONSTANTLY GROWING and BECOMING MORE AND MORE COMPETITIVE 2012 2018




LABOUR PRODUCTIVITY


