### MASOC – Association of Mechanical Engineering and Metalworking Industries of Latvia


- Established in 1994 as informative and consultative centre for the specified industrial sector

# MASOC – members' profile




The core group of companies cover various subsectors of metalworking and engineering (NACE 24, 25, 27, 28, 29 and 30)





# Mechanical engineering and metalworking sector in Latvia


- One of the biggest manufacturing sectors in Latvia:
  - Accounts for more than 17% of the total manufacturing output and value added (2014)
  - Second biggest exporting sector in 2014 (accounts for more than 21% of Latvian exports of goods)
- Exports over 70% of the output
- One of the fastest growing sectors in Latvia – both before and after crisis in 2009.
- Covers NACE 24, 25, 27, 28, 29, 30










